To solve this bothersome condition, Eye Eco Inc. has developed Tranquileyes, a new product that can bring immediate, long-lasting relief from dry, irritated eyes.

How It Works

According to the company, Tranquileyes restores moisture to the eye area by increasing humidity around the eye to help prevent the evaporation of the natural tear film. An ocular mask (called an eye cover) is designed to fit comfortably over the eye area and creates a high-humidity, moisture-rich environment that prevents evaporation of natural tears. The periocular skin also benefits from the mask by becoming hydrated, thereby minimizing the appearance of fine

Tranquileyes' cold-water therapy is best for reducing puffiness around eyes, relieving migraine symptoms, and invigorating tired eyes. The warm water therapy is best for soothing dry and tired eyes, relieving ocular itching, moisturizing the skin around the eyes, and improving the quality of rest and sleep.

The Eye Cover

Tranquileyes' eye covers are available in a choice of soothing colors. They are held in place with a comfortable head wrap that is easily adjusted to maintain a custom fit and a complete seal around the eye area.

The eye cover is anatomically designed to rest on the orbital bones, preventing restriction of blood flow to major blood vessels. Made of medical grade, flexible rubber, the eye cover provides comfort with complete occlusion of light. Two bridge sizes are included to permit a good fit for all patients.

An eye cushion is located on the concave side of the eye cover. This comfortable, fabric-lined cushion encircles the outer rim of the eye cover and lies against the skin. The cushion is made from visco-elastic, hypoallergenic foam. Body heat helps to mold the cushion to the facial contours, thus sealing the eye area from moisture evaporation.

Removable moisture pads, made of the same visco-elastic foam as the eye cushion, insert into the eye cushion.

Cold or Warm

The pads are designed to be removed, placed in warm or cold water, and replaced into the eye cushion. The temperature of the water determines the type of therapy used: warm water for soothing moisture, cool water to reduce swelling. Tranquileyes Waters™ Relax Formula can be sprayed on the moisture pad for the calming effect of lavender essential oil infusion.

Usage

Current dry eye therapy includes artificial tear supplements, lubricating ointments, anti-inflammatory solutions, punctal occlusion, bandage contact lens wear, moisture chamber goggles, and surgical correction.

Used as an adjunct to current therapy, Tranquileyes may dramatically reduce dry eye discomfort. Utilized as treatment for irritated eyes, this unique hydrating therapy can restore vital moisture to the eyes, offering the benefits of ocular comfort, visual clarity, and overall well-being. Outside the eyecare field, this product is gaining popularity in the travel, spa, and natural product industries.
